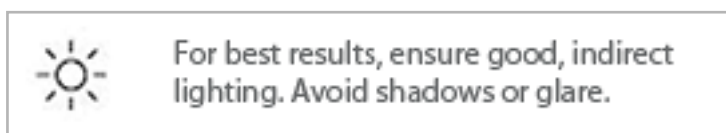




Five-Minute Guide

This Guide shows you how to:

- Scan photos
- Review cropped photos
- Edit and enhance
- Add captions
- Apply special effect filters
- Create albums
- Share photos

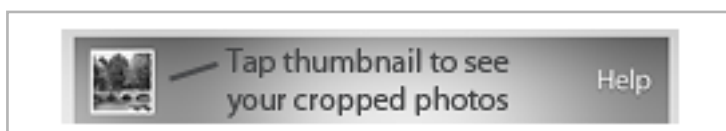


Scan Photos

- Place 1-3 photos on a white (or plain, un-textured) sheet of paper
- Keep all photos inside the sheet's edges, and ½" gap between photos
- Center the camera 8-10" above the photos, focus and shoot
- Review the photo: If OK, tap **Use**; if not, tap **Re-take**
- Repeat to scan more photos.

Review Photos

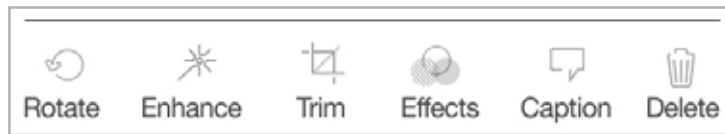
Tap thumbnail on Camera screen to go to gallery.



- Gallery shows cropped photos
- Tap a thumbnail to view the photo
- To hide toolbars, tap photo once. To re-display, tap again
- If a photo is missed or cropped wrong, either re-shoot or tap **Originals** and crop manually

Edit Photos

When viewing a photo, the Edit controls appear in the bottom bar:



- Rotate 90 degree at each tap
- Enhance brightness and contrast
- Trim (If auto-crop isn't perfect)
- Effects (Sepia, B&W etc.)
- Add captions (Date, place etc.)

Create Albums

From Cropped gallery, you can create a new album or add photos to an existing album.

To create a new album:

- Tap **Albums** > **Create new album**
- Type in new album's name
- On Albums screen, tap the album
- Tap **Edit** > **Add** to select photos

Share Photos

Now that your photos are digitized, you may want to share them.

- Tap **Select** on Cropped gallery screen
- Select one or more photos
- Tap 'Action' button, then choose from options

You must be online to access email, Facebook, Google+, Dropbox and Twitter.

Final Tips

- Activate iCloud on your device, and turn Pic Scanner 'On' for back up
- Review **Originals** gallery periodically and delete unneeded photos
- Do tell your friends about Pic Scanner!
